Outcome-Document

Due to this year's European Youth Cooperation Meeting youth delegates of the Hungary Red Cross, Lithuanian Red Cross, Polish Red Cross and German Red Cross Youth came together and established a new Youth Network – the Central European Youth Network (CEYN).

Within the framework of the Network we want to share best practices and to work more closely together as neighbouring Red Cross National Societies.

We elected with a unanimous assent Attila Szendrei of the Hungary Red Cross as chair.

Also we chose a Facebook Group as our main communication tool within the working group.

During our first meeting we wrote down a Working Plan.

The enacted CEYN's – Working Plan is as followed:

Until:

- 1. 1st of May 2018:**
 - Establishment of the Network
 - Creating an Outcome-Document
 - Establishing a Facebook group where every member has to introduce themself
- 2. 1st of June 2018:**
 - Appointment of up to three ambassadors per National Society participating in the Network; those have to share their E-Mail contacts and are added to the Facebook group
- 3. August 2018:**
 - Online-Meeting (preferential Skype conference) where we
 - a. Compose a declaration of intent
(Those intentions have to be conferred with National Societies' governing board beforehand)
- 4. 2019:**
 - Have a second Online Meeting that is fixed in the first conference
- 5. EYCM 2020:**
 - Creating a logo for CEYN
