Presentations should be held in English or German. Please indicate keywords: up to five keywords separated with comma. Please do not use references in the abstract.

Full Papers

The Paper should be written in English or German and submitted until the indicated deadline in MS WORD format following the formatting instructions under.

Text: Times New Roman, 12pts, 1.5 spacing, justified, up to 15,000 characters (with spaces), with the following margins: Top 2.5 cm; Bottom 2.5 cm; Left 3 cm; Right 3cm in MS WORD .doc / .docx format.

References: All sources should be listed in alphabetical order and in accordance with the APA Citation Style 6th edition (see on <https://libguides.library.usyd.edu.au/c.php?g=508212&p=3476096>).
